AS WE CONTINUE CREATING THE NEW TAW, HERE ARE ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS WE'RE RECEIVED:

Is the new TAW only for AVA members? The electronic version of the TAW is FREE for everyone, and will be a flipbook style newsletter. We encourage all club presidents and members to share the TAW when received. The TAW will also be on the website.

I want a printed version. You must opt in to receive a printed version (in others words, you must email <u>Hector</u> to have a printed version mailed to you), AND you must be a member of AVA.

Where do we send stories? The same email works for stories: taw@ava.org. Stories about upcoming walks will continue to be featured in your region's section or may be highlighted in its own section. You should copy your RD, so they know what will be included.


STARTING POINT BOOKS
